Grants Received:

Received \$50,000 grant from the W.K. Kellogg Foundation to promote literacy and diversity. Funding from the grant will make the records of Thomas A. Fleming's extensive collection of African American history and literature, which he is donating to EMU, available at the Halle Library as well as on the Internet.

Major library issues:

4.5 positions were lost during the year due to budget cuts

2 new tenure track faculty positions were authorized -- Humanities Librarian and Information Literacy Librarian

Inflation costs necessitated \$120,000 in cuts to the materials budget resulting in the cancellation of 370 journals, 256 standing orders, and 13 indexes/abstracts

Institutional Changes:

Dr. John Fallon becomes 21st President of EMU

Scott Muir resigns as Associate University Librarian

New degrees/programs:

12 new undergraduate majors and minors

7 new master's programs and 7 new graduate certificates.

Other significant academic changes:

None.

Library Facilities:

Remodeled the Bruce K. Nelson Faculty Development Center

Created a new audio/video viewing room which can accommodate up to 6 people.

Library Digital Projects:

Implemented Luna Insight, a digital images repository

Created EagleSpace digital repository to preserve, publicize and present the work of the EMU community. Two collections "Honors Theses" and "Theses and Dissertations" have been set up

Miscellaneous:

Completed first ever inventories of the library's circulating book collections

Processed the Thomas Fleming Afro-American Book Collection

Conducted online survey of EMU faculty concerning library collections and resources

Celebrated the 40th anniversary of EMU's federal depository library status
